PRIVATE TOUR of LLOYD'S OF LONDON Wednesday 20th March 2019 One Lime Street London EC2M 1JH

Since its beginnings in a coffee house in 1688 ó when it was founded by Edward Lloyd ó Lloydø has been a pioneer in insurance and grown over the 330+ years to become the worldø leading marked for specialist insurance.

Lloydø of London (known familiarly as Lloydø) needs little introduction and today is based deep in the East End of the City in an amazing building designed by Richard Rogers in Lime Street. With outside glassed lifts, from which unrivalled views can be had of the entire spread of London, to the famous historical Adam Room, the floors are redolent of the basic history of London and there are fascinating paintings, furniture and artefacts to be seen on some of the floors.

Central to the whole building, of course, are the trading floors, themselves still in the same format as the original structure and modernised only to incorporate modern market methods. But the description of the historical centre of the building will be given by our guide/s, who themselves worked there for significant amounts of time, and we are fortunate indeed that our Chairman himself worked there also and can add his very personal outline of life within the walls. If you can manage to get there from 5.00 pm, there may be the opportunity to see some at least of the øboxesø still manned and working, although the majority of those based inside Lloydø go back to their own offices nearby in the late afternoon. However, even for those who cannot get there until later, there is still much to see.

To enable Lloydø to produce the necessary passes, they need your first name and surname, so I shall be grateful if you ensure that you include this/these below.
